Wheelers have lots to look at while there, a Maple Heritage Museum with the largest collection of Maple Syrup artifacts in the world, a Forest and Farm Museum with over 600 vintage chainsaws and many unique farming tools and many more activities and displays. Vernon Wheeler, the family patriarch will give us a presentation on Maple Syrup production and how his system operates and will be glad to answer your questions.

After we have eaten and been enlightened about Maple Syrup production at Wheelers, we will proceed to our place at *2275 Bennett Lake Road, Tayvalley Twsp, Maberly, Ont., K0H 2B0* which as the crow flies is about 6kms from Wheelers but by road is about 25kms. We will then visit my neighbours much smaller but very new and up to date Maple Syrup operation. Mr. Paul Smith will be happy to answer your questions. And hopefully we can finish the day at our place with refreshments and food. We may be able to offer other activities depending on the weather such as Snowmobiling, Cross Country Skiing, Snowshoeing.
